

Dinner and discussion of American Judaism from 1654 to the present (and future) with the acclaimed scholar who wrote the bestselling book on the subject, *American Judaism:* A History, and who will be teaching at Harvard in the Spring. Beginning in the colonial era, Sarna recounts the dynamic story of people struggling to be Americans and Jews. He shows how each generation of American Jews has had to wrestle anew with the question of whether Judaism can survive freedom.
